About Bible School

The Bible School is arranged to provide a few days centred around the Word of God. Brethren, sisters, young people and children will enjoy time together in Bible study, reflection, discussion and recreation. The aim is to strengthen our resolve to follow the Master and prepare for his return.

Location

Harper Adams University College is set in the heart of the Shropshire countryside. It is a quiet and attractive venue for the Bible School and we enjoy the use of many acres of landscaped grounds. Accommodation

Residential accommodation is in single en-suite bedrooms. Bed linen, soap, towels and all meals are provided.

The Campsite is for families and young people to bring their own caravans and tents on a self-catering basis. Meals in the dining room can be ordered in advance, or alternatively can be purchased from the college cafeteria. Sites are on level grass with showers and toilets nearby. There are water and waste disposal points, laundry facilities and limited fridge and freezer space. There is a convenience shop on the campus and supermarkets in Newport 2.5 miles away.

Non-residents from local ecclesias are welcome for the whole school. Booking is essential and there is a charge for registration and meals.



Facilities

- Lift to the Conference Hall and Seminar rooms
- Infrared sound reinforcement in Conference Hall
- Bible School Bookshop
- Separate classes for children and young people
- Video relay into the quiet crèche and an activity crèche for toddlers
- Heated outdoor swimming pool
- Tennis and squash courts, sports hall and playing fields

Activities

The programme includes Bible readings and studies in the mornings and evenings. In the afternoons brethren and sisters attend a class of their choice followed by free time with sport and leisure activities. On Friday there is a family evening meal followed by a summary presentation of the week's studies and activities. The week concludes on Saturday with a Breaking of Bread.

Children and young people have separate classes during all the adult sessions. Supervised activities, games, sports and swimming are arranged during afternoon and evening free time.

What is a 'Pitch'?

One tent/caravan/campervan that accommodates the immediate family group and, if needed, an additional one- or two-man sleeper tent no greater than 160cm x 340 cm. Anything larger than this combination is charged as two pitches.

Guidelines

1. All are expected to attend the sessions and classes on the main programme.
2. Please notify the teacher or a committee member if your child will not be at a class or activity.
3. Parents and guardians are responsible for their children outside organised activities.
4. Bedrooms and property are to be respected, please report any damages.
5. You may not swap or change rooms without prior approval.
6. Please respect bed times and quietness around the campsite, rooms and corridors.
7. Please take special care that you are dressed modestly so as not to cause offence.
8. Sisters are asked to wear a head covering to the main sessions.
9. Badges are to be worn to satisfy University and Bible School requirements.
10. Please wear footwear at all times around the campus. Trainers **MUST** be worn in the Sports Hall.
11. Report incidents of accidents or illness.
